With his landmark book The Kinsey Report, he established a precedent that most sex researchers would follow, with notable exceptions. From the beginning, however, the science of sexual behavior has faced a problem. Whereas advances in medicine and the cell-phone industry boast annual record low failures rates, the field of human sexuality is still littered with academic dead ends. This is due in part to the statistical prevalence of "pseudoscience," according to a series of scientific principles that are often time-honored but not necessarily valid for drawing conclusions from data. The problem is most notable when it comes to things like gay and lesbian attraction. Which way does such a thing run? If more male students come out as gay than female students, is this because boys are just naturally more sexually active than girls? If gay men live longer than straight men, is it because of the health benefits of being straight? Is the more frequent sexual encounter of the 20-something single female simply due to having less options? In a new paper published in the International Journal of Transgenderism, two New York City-based psychologists argue that these questions should be answered by scientists — not science fiction writers or fake news sites or, for that matter
